Some suggestions to be added to the survey would be questions concerning solar, 5G boxes which would be attached to poles on our streets, short term rentals in the village, and a cannabis dispensary located in our village. This flyer could also ask for committee members from the residents.

The PB would like to recommend that Diana Spenello be reappointed back to the PB. She has been contacted and is willing to serve on the PB.
