Old Business:

The sign for the Odds and Ends Thrift shop were reviewed by the county and was sent back to us as a local matter. Sign had been approved at last month's meeting. Jesse Wilcox said the sign was already installed.

The subdivision between 110 Autumn Lane and Jackson Field had been reviewed during the public hearing but needed a SEQR which was done at the meeting, Lisa Scott sent it to the County Planning Commission for their review. It is to be reviewed during their September meeting.

185 Main St. was again discussed and Mike Piccolo was called with questions and what could be done. It was decided that Jesse Wilcox needs to discuss the issues with Mr. Veley.

New Business:

The person at 195 Summit St. wanted to know if the village could put up a mirror at the end of her driveway so she could see if the road was clear before pulling out onto Summit St.
