Streets

- Mowing and trimming is slowing down.
- Jason has been trimming trees around the village that are difficult to see around.
- The time is coming for a new pickup truck, and the backhoe is on borrowed time as well. I would like to put all the vehicles we have in storage, in the county auction, if that's ok? Brian Manchester is going to set me up with his John Deere contact. I will start to get prices.

Water

- The plant is running great.
- I am still waiting for my final report for the CPE.
- I ordered a new probe for our Fluoride analyzer, which was one of the things to address in our CPE. Waiting for that to arrive. I also ordered the "flow pacers" for the Chlorine and Alum chemical pumps. They arrived last Wednesday. I will have Aqualogics come and install them as they must set them up in our SCADA system for alarm purposes.
- We worked on Marshal Roberts curb valve. He was complaining of pressure issues. We replaced a section by his curb valve that had a 2-foot piece of galvanized, and several fittings. When we removed that piece, you could see the scale, and tuberculous that built up inside reducing a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe to about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Galvanized pipe is notorious for buildup on the pipe wall. We also gave him a new water meter; all of this seems to have helped.
- As far as lead service line inspections goes, we have all the Village side accounted for. We have 255 public service hookups. Of those we currently have 142 of them inspected. Inspections will continue until the last day, October 14th. When the report gets sent in, all the "unknown" services will have to have a letter mailed to them stating that an inspection couldn't be done in time, we will be there asap. This letter is going to be a template that the government will supply us with. That way the wording is the same for everyone. The report will not be complete until there are no unknowns.

Sewer

- The plant is running great
- Plant efficiency has been around 98% removal for BOD and 97% removal for TSS.
