*You do not need to pay online to view, print or manage your account.

*You can pay your bill online @ www.richmondvillevillage.org. Your name is your account number, phone number(must be the one you gave us). Verify account, create username and password. (There is a nominal fee to pay onlinesee below.)

*<u>All credit card payments incur a fee</u> since they go through a 3rd party.(online, on the phone or in the office). The fee is \$2.75 or 2.5% of your bill, whichever is greater.
