

Village of Richmondville Planning Board:

Meeting date- Thursday January 17,2023

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Lisa Scott at 4:17. Linda Carpenter and Ryan Snyder were excused from the meeting. Joan Sondergaard acted as secretary. Present were Lisa Scott, Scott Hill, Joan Sondergaard, and Jesse Wilcox (code enforcer officer). Village trustee Diana Spenello was present on zoom. We stood for the pledge of allegiance.

The minutes of the December 15, 2022, meeting was approved on motion from Scott Hill and seconded by Joan Sondergaard.

There was no correspondence.

Old Business: The motion and resolution sent to the board were approved. Ryan Snyder can be the Village Planning Board Representative to the Village Trustee Board and speak on our behalf.

Jesse Wilcox updated the board on zoning concerns previously discussed. The Hotaling sign will be replaced with a conforming one. St. Paul's Lutheran Church request for neon sign has been denied. A letter has been sent to the Laundry Mat about their sign of too many colors. No response yet. Mr. Veley still must be contacted about the parking situation at the garage/apartment. Joan Sondergaard complained once again about the scrap yard at a neighbor's yard.

New Business: Lisa Scott brought up the writing of solar panel regulations. Hope has sent a list of Villages that have adopted such regulations for their Village. Lisa will speak with Shane Nichols to get some copies of their regulations plus the State requirements, so we do not have to start from scratch with a model to follow. She will invite Shane to our next meeting

The Comprehensive plan writing is on hold. The trustees are concerned about the cost of a consultant. The resolution the board made is being revised. The Trustees want the Planning Board to rewrite it.

Lisa reported not getting any follow-ups after the trustees meetings.
