- *You can pay your bill online @ www.richmondvilllevillage.org. Your name is your account number, phone number (must be the one you gave us). Verify account, create username and password. (There is a nominal fee to pay online-see below.)
- *All credit card payments incur a fee since they go through a 3rd party. (online, on the phone or in the office). The fee is \$2.75 or 2.5% of your bill, whichever is greater.
